Subject : Guidelines for SPAB/DPAB

It has been observed that the SPAB/DPAB sometimes failed to take various aspects into consideration while recommending rates for purchase of materials and this has resulted in increase in the expenditure. It is, therefore, decided that, in future, the prevailing rates of items in the local markets and also the printed price of the Company or Authorised Dealers, if any, should be enclosed in the Agenda note so as to enable the SPAB/DPAB to compare the existing local market rates with the rates offered by the Quotationers/Tenderers before recommending rates for purchase of materials.

It is further decided that the Department should enclose the statement showing the existing local market rates and the rates recommended by the SPAB/DPAB in the minutes while obtaining approval of Government.
