CIRCULAR

Subject: Maintenance of Financial Discipline and lowering the Fiscal Deficit of the State – reg.


In pursuance of the identified actionable points of the State Government arising out of “the 70th Plenary Meeting of the North Eastern Council” where maintenance of Financial Discipline and lowering the Fiscal Deficit of the States was identified as need of the hour, all Departments under Government of Mizoram are hereby requested to adhere to the following measures to maintain Financial Discipline and to lower Fiscal Deficit of the State–

1. It may be aware that Finance Department has no separate source of additional resources. Thus, additional allocation without commensurate increase in revenue results in increase in Fiscal Deficit.
2. All Budget Controlling Authorities are therefore requested to restrict their expenditure within the B.E. provided for the respective financial year.
3. Finance Department will not entertain any additional allocation without the corresponding source of revenue except in case of emergency.
