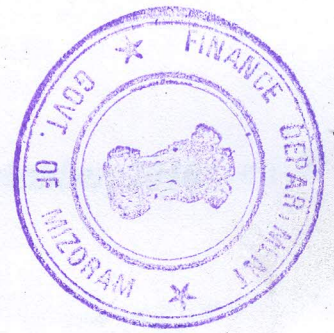

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Aizawl, the 7th September, 2010

Subject: Payment of family pension to divorced/un - married /widowed daughters

In continuation of this Department's Office Memorandum No. G- 19011/9/2007- F.APF/Pt Dt 26.7.2007 and 3.9.2008 and in line with Government of India, Office Memorandum. No. 116/08-P& PW(E) Dt 22.6.2010, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to order that the Chief Controller of Accounts & Treasuries, Mizoram, shall be the statutory authority to identify the genuineness and pass appropriate order on claims for family pension of divorced/un-married/widowed daughters whose names are not included in the family declaration of the deceased Govt. employees, keeping the following grounds in view while examining applications for family pension from widowed, unmarried or divorced daughters.

In cases where the names of eligible children have not been mentioned in the PPO for various reasons, the pensioner while alive should have furnished a list of eligible children to the pension sanctioning authority and obtain an acknowledgement thereof from that authority. This acknowledgement will be produced at the time of submission of family pension claim to the pension sanctioning authority. However, the production of an acknowledgement will not be a pre - condition for pass-over of family pension. Even the spouse of the dead Government servant/pensioner can furnish the details of such Children, if not furnished by the Government servant/pensioner while in active service or after retirement but before his/her death.

Similarly, in cases where the pensioner or his/her spouse has expired, the widowed or divorced or unmarried daughter can themselves intimate such details to the pension sanctioning authority. However, the family pension in such cases can be processed by the pension sanctioning authority even without such intimation/acknowledgement, if sufficient proof of entitlement e.g. Certificate of a competent court or other competent authority is produced by the claimant and all other conditions issued in this regard vide this office Notification No. G. 19011/23/2003-F.APF dated 26th July 2007 and 3rd September 2008 for grant of family pension are fulfilled.
